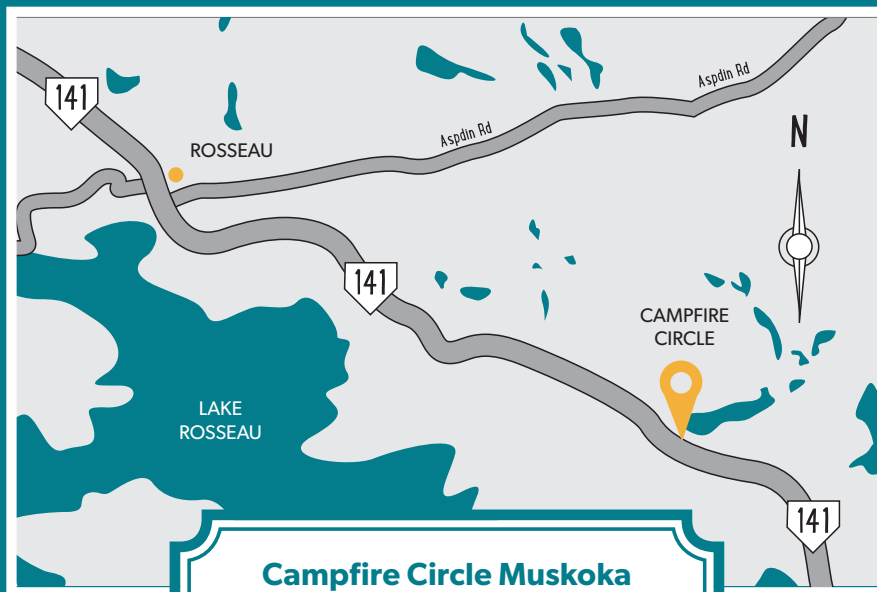

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THE CAMPFIRE CIRCLE BRAID

At Campfire Circle, hand-woven braids are a camp tradition symbolizing courage, community, friendship, and fun. Each camper and volunteer creates their own braid as a celebration of individuality and creativity.

Over time, this braid grows along with its wearer, adorned with tokens that celebrate special moments at camp. These personal pieces of "bling" include everything from arts & crafts creations to special awards from counsellors, mementos of milestone achievements, or reminders of special people. Each braid is worn with pride and is as unique as the camper who wears it.

Often found on campers' button braids are Steps in the Right Direction—colourful, foot-shaped stickers. Each day at camp, campers present "steps" to their friends, cabinmates, and counsellors. In this way, campers recognize each other for the successes, special moments, and qualities that make each of them unique.
