



DIY Mini Putt

Follow the instructions below for an awesome at home Mini Putt game that you and your family can play together!

Feel like a Golfer

- Put on your best golfing gear! Things like a sweater vest, shorts, sun hat, gloves, etc. will all help you get in the golfer mindset. If you don't have any of this, no worries! Use the paper visor template attached to make one of your own.
- Make a golf ball by crunching aluminum foil into a ball. Make sure there is one for everyone who will be playing! You can wrap them in tape or cover them in paper to customize!
- Make a golf club by taping a cardboard rectangle to the end of a broom handle.

Decorate a Scorecard

- Along the side of your scorecard you should have a list of the names of all the players - you can even give everyone a cool golf nickname like "Big Shot".
- On the top of the scorecard, you should have the numbers of all the holes. That will give you space to write everyone's scores!

- Straws
- Tape & Scissors

Create a Course

- Now it's time to make your very own mini putt course! Use a cup as the hole. Your golf course can have as many holes as you like - we suggest 9 as a good number.
- Have fun and be creative! Here are some ideas to get you started:
 - Have a hole that goes down your stairs
 - Could it go from inside to outside?
 - Make a tiny version using a tiny ball & a straw or a giant version using a pool noodle & soccer ball
 - Use lots of different obstacles like cushions, kitchen utensils, clothes, toys and more!
 - Make some holes easier and some a bit harder.

Paper Visor Template

Print out the template below to create your very own golfing visor! Cut out the shape and trace it onto construction paper, foam, or use it as is. Create two holes where they are shown on the template, then connect them using string or pipe cleaners so that you can wear it!
