

Sporting Life 10K Raises Record-Breaking \$2.5M in Support of Campfire Circle

The 25th anniversary of the event saw 23,000 participants in Toronto on Mother's Day, virtual run throughout May

Toronto, June 17, 2025— On Mother's Day, Sunday, May 11th, over 23,000 participants laced up and took to Yonge Street for the 25th annual <u>Sporting Life 10K</u>. The event raised a record-breaking \$2.5 million in support of <u>Campfire Circle</u>, a charity that provides camp experiences for kids with cancer or serious illness and their families.

The Sporting Life 10K, one of the biggest running events of the year, has cumulatively raised more than \$29 million for Campfire Circle. An additional 570+ people participated virtually in the 10K throughout May.
