LEADERSHIP OVERNIGHT



CAMPFIRE CIRCLE MUSKOKA Near the town of Rosseau

Eligibility: Patients, bereaved siblings, or siblings.

Leaders in Training 1 (LIT 1) | Ages 16-17

Learn how to work with younger campers, facilitate camp programs, and build leadership skills in a camp setting. All LIT 1s will earn 15 volunteer hours and improve their teamwork, communication, and problem-solving abilities.

LIT 1: Option 1 | July 2 – 13 This LIT option includes a 4-day canoe trip.

This LIT option includes an accessible, 2-day camping trip.

Leaders in Training 2 (LIT 2) | Ages 17-18

Build on leadership and program facilitation skills shadowing experienced volunteers and staff. LIT 2s will do a placement with a younger cabin to gain practical experience working as a cabin counsellor. LIT 2s will earn 20 volunteer hours and tangible experience to add to their resumes.

Learn advanced canoeing skills and how to live in the wilderness on a 9-day, white-water canoe trip on the French River. Campers will spend 2 days at camp in Muskoka before departing on the trip, which will start and end at the Muskoka site.
